

Surrounded by snowy peaks, the reflection of the mountains in the still waters creates a picture-perfect scene. The trek also includes an ascent to Gokyo Ri, a vantage point that provides an unobstructed 360-degree panorama of the entire

The traditional tea houses along the route offer a cozy retreat for rest and rejuvenation, with hearty meals that replenish energy for the next day's adventure.
